1. User Guide

Check-in time	From 13:00 to 16:00
Check-out time	8:30 to 10:00 a.m.
Campground entrance opening/closing hours	Gates open at 8:30 and close at 19:00
	Entrance and exit after the gate closes is permitted

2. Terms of Use

Please observe the following rules when using our campground facilities.

garbage disposal	You will be required to purchase garbage bags for a fee. (Burnable and non-burnable trash: 220 yen each, tax included) Non-burnable trash: bottles, cans, etc. Burnable trash: plastic bottles, food scraps, etc.
Fireworks	All fireworks (including hand-held fireworks) are prohibited.
Extension	Use after check-out (parking, river play, etc.) is considered extended use. Please refer to the separate sheet "Extension" for details.
Parking during your stay	At the camp site, park in the sand area (no riding up on the grass). Bungalows should be parked in designated parking areas. Please move with the slowest possible speed inside the site.
Use of fire (grill, bonfire, etc.)	Please use footed cooking utensils, fire pits, etc. and use them on the sand portion of the site or on wooden decks. In bungalows, please use the designated area on the terrace.
Shower	Please do not use fire (including equipment with legs) or place griddles or other items directly on the l Coin-operated showers (200 yen per shower) are available 24 hours a day. (Not by appointment only) 100 yen coins are required. Currency exchange is available at the Administration Building.
Kitchen tower	Available 24 hours a day, please turn off the lights at the end of the day. Please use the room cleanly for later use.
Boating or swimming in a river	Please be sure to play safely when accompanied by an adult. The other side of the river is cut off and off-limits. We are not responsible for accidents in the river.
Fishing	Fishing in the river requires the purchase of a separate fishing ticket from the Fisheries Cooperative Association. (High school students and older)
No Smoking	Smoking is prohibited in all buildings and tents. Please smoke in the designated area in front of the administration building (ashtrays are provided) or Smoking in your campsite or on the terrace of your bungalow. Please bring your own ashtray.
Other	*We ask for your cooperation in avoiding the use of shared facilities (cooking building, restrooms, powder room, shower rooms, etc.) by large groups of people and avoiding close proximity. Please keep them clean and share them with others.
	Please do not deface or destroy buildings or nature.
	Please be quiet so as not to disturb other guests. (Especially at night, even the slightest voice will be echoed due to the quiet surroundings. (Especially after 9:00 p.m., loud voices are prohibited.)
	Please do not enter dangerous activities or areas. The campground is not responsible for any accidents. We are not responsible for any accidents or theft problems on the premises. Please take care of your valuables by yourself. Please observe the prohibited items. You may be asked to leave the premises if you do not observe the prohibited items.

3. Prohibitions

Speaker Use	Radios, smart phones, game consoles, video and music players, etc. Prohibition of speaker use
Sound Acts	No musical instruments, banquets, karaoke, etc.
Fire prevention	Prohibit the use of fire inside the building and the use of open flames on the grounds and in the river. Use of fires on the lawn (charcoal grills, bonfires), placing griddles, mosquito coils, etc. on the lawn, etc.
No vehicles allowed on the lawn	Unnecessary movement of vehicles and prohibition of idling or use of generators in the facility Prohibition of acts for business purposes or acts that may disturb other guests. Prohibition of acts that damage the building or nature, including graffiti, etc. (In the event of damage, you may be charged for repairs.) No pets are allowed. (However, guide dogs, etc. are allowed.)
